VENUE

Exhibition Stalls will be located around the perimeter of the **Hunter Halls** in the University's Main Building:

This venue will be the focal point of the Congress and will host coffee breaks and posters sessions throughout the week.

EXHIBITION SPACE DIMENSIONS

Each stall will hold one chair and two tables (with tablecloth), measuring together approx. **1.5 m x 0.5 m** (longways) or **0.75 x 1 m** (two-deep). (Exact table measurement: 77 x 46 cm.)

Any exhibitors wishing a **larger display area** should indicate this as early as possible so that the necessary arrangements can be made.

Any exhibitors wishing to display material for Monday and Tuesday only, or for Thursday and Friday only, are asked to indicate this as early as possible so that the availability of stalls each day can be identified.
